

CAZA Professional Fellow Application

Professional Fellow members shall be persons who are employed full time in a management capacity by an accredited Institutional member.

Professional Fellow membership applications shall first be endorsed by their Institutional Chief Executive and one Professional Fellow, Retired Professional Fellow or Director Emeritus. All Institutional Chief Executives require endorsement by a combination of two Professional Fellows, Retired Professional Fellows or Director Emeritus - one of whom must be from an organization other than that of the applicant.

Professional Fellow members shall enjoy full membership privileges including the right to vote, to be elected to the Board of Directors and to serve as an officer in CAZA.

MEMBERSHIP FEE: \$100
