

CAZA Retired Professional Fellow Application

Retired Professional Fellow members shall be retired persons who have been Professional Fellow members in good standing for the last ten years and have made meaningful contributions to CAZA as determined by the Board of Directors. Retired Professional Fellows shall enjoy core membership privileges, except the right to vote and hold elective office. For the purpose of this membership, retirement means the termination of regular employment due to age or health, in accordance with the standard retirement policies of the member's employer. Application to this category can be made by the Fellow member candidate or by a Board member on behalf of the candidate.
